Academy of Clinician Scholars

The Academy of Clinician Scholars solicits applications for travel to scholarly meetings. Applications can be submitted throughout the year but must be received prior to the conference start date. Applications will be reviewed while funds are available.

Health Science Clinical Series Faculty with a MD, DO or PharmD can receive ONE trip every other fiscal year (July 1-June 30). Travel awards (domestic or foreign) will be made for a maximum of \$1,000 towards any standard economy airfare and/or registration fees only (documentation required). Funds cannot be used to pay for attendance to any postgraduate courses or other supplemental educational courses or business class fares.

ELIGIBILITY

- HS Clinical Series faculty
- Accepted abstract to a scientific professional society conference.
- Not a member of the Academic Senate.
- Either the first or senior author on the podium oral or poster presentation of original clinical research only.
- Chair verification of greater than 50% clinical FTE.

NOT ELIGIBLE

- Invited lectures
- Workshops, panel or moderator invites
- Postgraduate or supplemental education courses
- Business or first-class ticket
- Tenure track and tenured Professors
- In-Resident Professors
- Professors of Clinical X
- Lecturers w/SOE or PSOE
- Faculty on MSP contracts
- Adjunct Series

Preference will be given to those invited to give oral presentations on new research topics not funded by any existing grants and/or those not be funded directly by the conference.

Application Process

Submit the following documentation:

- Complete an application (applications can be found at <https://medschool.ucsd.edu/aocs/grants/travel/Pages/default.aspx>)
- Department Chair/Division Chief verification of greater than 50% clinical FTE.
- Copy of abstract
- Copy of abstract acceptance letter
- Airfare price quote from a travel agency.
- Registration fee receipt or invoice.
