Postdoctoral fellow – fibrinolysis proteins in innate immunity

Post-doctoral positions are available to study receptor systems and cell-signaling pathways that control the response of macrophages and other immune system cells to TLRs and other Pattern Recognition Receptors. A background in biochemistry and molecular biology is preferred. Our studies apply cell culture model systems and also, mouse models of diseases in which chronic inflammation plays an important role. Applicants are encouraged to examine publications from the Gonias laboratory (which now number over 200) to understand our scope of research interests.

Candidates should hold a Ph.D. and have completed no more than three years of post-doctoral work at the time of application. Positions will be funded by newly acquired NIH grants. Salaries are paid at NIH scale.
