Dr Broide received his medical degree in 1976 from the University of Cape Town in South Africa. He completed an internship at Groote Schuur Hospital in Cape Town, and residency in internal medicine in the Harvard affiliated Peter Bent Brigham/Waltham program in Boston. After completing a fellowship in allergy/immunology at the University of California in San Diego, in 1987 he joined the faculty of the University of California San Diego where he is currently a Professor of Medicine. Dr Broide has been included in Best Doctors in America and has been elected to the Association of American Physicians. He has authored over 160 publications in the field of mechanisms of asthma and novel therapies for asthma. His basic and translational research program has been funded by the National Institutes of Health for over 25 years and he is currently the recipient of an NIH MERIT award, and is principal investigator on several NIH RO1 grants as well as an NIH Asthma and Allergic Disease Center. He has served on NIH grant review study sections, as Associate Editor of the *Journal of Allergy and Clinical Immunology*, secretary of the American Board of Allergy Immunology, and as a member of the Board of Directors of the American Academy of Allergy Asthma and Immunology.
