	Have completed training in a program relevant to Pathology and be eligible to complete a certification examination of the American Board of Pathology or equivalent examination
Assistant Clinical Professor	
	Have fulfilled all of the criteria for a Clinical Instructor Be board certified or board eligible in a program relevant to Pathology and be board certified or equivalent within 2 years of reaching this level
Associate Clinical Professor	
	 Have fulfilled all of the criteria for Assistant Clinical Professor Have participated in the educational programs of the department Have served as Assistant Clinical Professor for 5 years <u>OR</u> have 5 years of service as an attending pathologist or practitione in an area relevant to pathology
Clinical Professor	
	Have fulfilled all of the criteria for Associate Clinical Professor Appointment or promotion to Professor implies special skills or contributions and these should be explicitly documented Have served as Associate Clinical Professor for 5 years OR have 10 years of service as an attending pathologist or practitioner in an area relevant to pathology

*NOTE: Non-salaried Health Sciences Clinical series appointments (e.g., non-salaried Health Sciences Assistant Clinical Professor) are given to individuals who have employment elsewhere in the University of California (e.g., another campus, the medical center, staff physician) while Voluntary Clinical series appointments (e.g., Voluntary Assistant Clinical Professor) are given to individuals in the community. All individuals must contribute to the clinical teaching mission of the Department.
